Description of Modifications:

The drainage channel through the water treatment plant property is eroding. Proposed improvements to the channel would include design of erosion resistant channel components and construction engineering services while the channel is being improved by the Contractor. As a result, the amount of lump sum compensation as listed in C2.01 A.1. shall be increased by \$9,000.

The reconstruction of 8th Street north of the water treatment plant property and the east side of Oak Street on the west side of the water treatment plant property is desired by the Owner. This work will involve additional design and construction phase engineering services amounting to \$16,200. The Rural Development and City Share of this amount are \$5,346 and \$10,854, respectively.

The project is taking longer than expected to complete. As a result, the lump sum compensation listed in C2.01. A.1 shall be increased by \$40,000 from \$624,000 to \$664,000

to accommodate additional construction meetings, preparation of additional applications for payment and additional project coordination.

The time expected for the Resident Project Representative services was over-estimated. Therefore, amounts of compensation as listed in C2.04 A.1. shall be decreased by \$40,000 from \$175,000 to \$135,000.

The number of construction days for part-time RPR shall be increased by an estimated 100 days from the previously described construction schedule.



WHEREAS the programs in place today to assist inmates in learning a trade and increasing their chances of success upon their release is a direct result of the facility being the former home of the vocational college, the University of South Dakota at Springfield; and,
