

TITLE XV

THE BODY OF CITY ORDINANCES

CHAPTER 15.01

GENERAL PROVISIONS

15.0101 Title of Ordinance

This ordinance, being a complete revision of the ordinances of the City of Springfield, South Dakota, shall be know as Ordinance Number 400 and any ordinance to be hereafter adopted shall be numbered consecutively above that number.

15.0102 Amendments

This ordinance or any section, chapter or title thereof, may be amended as provided by law, but any such amendment shall specifically define and describe the section, chapter and title so amended and such amendment shall cover and embody the entire portion so amended and such portion so amended shall be entirely rewritten.

15.0103 Validity

Should any section, paragraph, sentence clause, or phrase of this ordinance be declared invalid or unconstitutional for any reason, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected thereby.

15.0104 Vested Rights

Nothing in this ordinance shall be so construed as to impair any vested right or valid obligation existing when it takes effect.

15.0105 Franchises

Ordinances heretofore adopted granting any franchise, right of way, easement or contract right shall not be affected by this ordinance.

15.0106 Location of Poles, Wires, Etc.

Ordinances relating to location of electric light, telephone and telegraph poles and wires in streets and alleys and/or other public places, shall not be affected by this ordinance.

15.0107 Bonds

Ordinances, providing for the issuance of general obligation bonds, revenue bonds, or special assessment certificates or bonds in lieu thereof of the City of Springfield shall not be affected by this ordinance.

15.0108 Appropriations

Ordinances making appropriations shall not be affected by this ordinance.

15.0109 Repeal Clause

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance or relating to the subject matter of this ordinance and not re-enacted as part of this ordinance, except as stated in this chapter, are hereby repealed.

15.0110 Good Faith Statement

Nothing in this ordinance, nor portions thereof, is/are intended to create a cause of action or claim against the City of Springfield, its officials, appointees, or employees running to specific individuals, or groups, companies or firms, or other segments of the public or society, public or private. Any duty or right created herein is intended to be a general duty or right running in favor of the public citizenry.

15.0111 Publication and Effect

This Ordinance shall be typed and published in loose-leaf book form and shall take effect as provided by law.
